3 In the master bath of an apartment on Manhattan's Upper East Side, architect and designer Daniel Romualdez constructed a shower room with acid-etched glass walls and marble floors and equipped it with a bench of his own design. The Waterworks tub has Dornbracht fittings. 4 Architect David Pickert and designer Nate Berkus outfitted the Chicago apartment of antiques dealer Mary Jeanne Reese with a glass-enclosed shower

stall in the master bath. The floor and the shower interior are of recut marble from Reese's architectural salvage firm, Au Coin du Feu; the fittings, sinks, and medicine cabinets are by Waterworks.

5 For the mid-19th-century London townhouse of fashion-magazine editor Kim Hersov, interior designer Hubert Zandberg created a walk-in shower sheathed in horn panels by Rex in a variety of sizes and colors.
